MINUTES
CITY OF CEDAR HILL
BEAUTIFICATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY BOARD MEETING
DECEMBER 19, 2019

The Beautification and Environmental Sustainability Board met on Thursday, December 19, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Briefing Room of the Government Center, 285 Uptown Blvd., Cedar Hill, Texas. The following Board members were present: Andrew Adams, Brian Hart, Roland Fuller, Robert Largent, Bernetta Jo Young, Jai-W Hayes-Jackson, Lester Singleton, Gerald Malone. The following Board members were absent: Sandra McLain, Delores Shaw. The following City staff members were present: Duy Vu. Additional attendees: none.

I. Call meeting to order

Hart called the meeting to order at 6:08 pm.

II. Approve minutes of October 17, 2019

Hart motioned for the approval of minutes from October 17, 2019. Hayes-Jackson seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.

III. Citizen's Forum

Hart opened the Citizen's Forum. No citizens were present. Hart closed the Citizen's Forum.

IV. Waste Management Contract Update

Hart updated the Board on the changes to bulk pickup. Starting February 2020, bulk and brush will be combined into one 10 cubic yard pile once per month. The pile will be called "Bulk Collection." Call-in services will be eliminated. Rates will be reduced 4% when the change is implemented.

Changes in the bulk pickup schedule were to reduce confusion among residents and to enhance the overall appearance of Cedar Hill.

Changes went to City Council on December 10 and was approved.

Hayes-Jackson volunteered to speak to City Council about the Green Awards through a January 14 council agenda item.

Adams and Malone volunteered to speak to City Council about the Green Awards through a January 28 council agenda item.
