BEAUTIFICATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY BOARD MEETING
MAY 20, 2021

I. Call meeting to order

Hart called the meeting to order at 6:03 pm.

II. Approve minutes of April 15, 2021

IV. In-Person Meetings

V. At-Your-Door Special Collection

Vu presented to the Board on the At-Your-Door Special Collection (AYDSC). AYDSC is a service provided by Waste Management for household hazardous waste and electronic waste. AYDSC will replace the Environmental Collection Program. The City will still hold shred events quarterly. AYDSC will cost \$15 per resident.

The Board supported the program but inquired on a communications plan and a method for public input.

VU intended to present the program to City Council on May 25, 2021.
