I. Call the meeting to order.

Jennifer Hutchinson called the meeting to order at 7:06 pm declaring it an open meeting with notice of the meeting duly posted.

II. Approve the Minutes of January 21 and February 18 meeting.

Marlow Stevenson made a motion, seconded by Toby Gentry, to approve the minutes of the January 21 and February 18 Regular Meeting. The motion passed unanimously.
