X. Neighborhood Incident Report by Corporal Brackenridge

- On February 10, Officers detained two juveniles and an adult that fired shots into the air to get a reaction from a nearby officer.
- On February 18, the flock camera notified officers of a stolen vehicle that entered the neighborhood and was found parked in the Methodist clinic parking lot. Stolen vehicle offences have skyrocketed in the DFW area.
- Cedar Hill PD has hired a new criminologist that will be able to provide a monthly stat of each neighborhood
- The citizen police academy flyer was presented to meeting attendees. The event will be held on Thursdays.
