I. Call the Board of Director's meeting to order

Jennifer called the meeting to order at 7:03pm

II. Citizens Forum

Robert Riggs presented information on the Cedar Hill ISD VATRE.

III. Approve Minutes from the May 20, 2023, regular meeting

Gina made a motion to approve the May 20, 2023, regular meeting minutes, seconded by James. The motion passed unanimously.

IV. Election Results

Jennifer informed the board that she and Myrna would be re-appointed to the board and that a new board member will join named Aron Biskey at the October regular meeting. Toby Gentry will be removed from the board.

V. Update on DeSoto Rotary Club - flag program

Jennifer updated the board on a flag program that was suggested by James. The flag program will consist of the DeSoto Rotary Club placing American flags in the common areas of Winding Hollow neighborhood for up to 6 holidays. The cost of the program is \$300 - \$400/year.

VI. Discuss and vote on landscaping maintenance contract

Gina made a motion to approve A & J Landscaping to provide monthly landscaping services for Winding Hollow PID at the quoted rate of \$450/month, seconded by James. The motion passed unanimously. The presented quote also included planting new trees at \$250 each upon request.

Jennifer updated the board on National Night Out activities. She has arranged for hot dogs, chips, drinks, and cookies and/or cake pops. The Block Party Trailer has been reserved and the event will take place from 6 to 8PM. Postcard notifications have been mailed out as well.
