**Main Street Board**  
**DART Rail Field Study of September 27, 2010**

*The Main Street Development and Preservation Board of the City of Cedar Hill, Texas met on Monday, September 27, 2010 at 3:00 pm. in the lobby of the Cedar Hill Government Center.*

Members boarded the train, riding the full length of the RED LINE to Parker Rd. Station, staying aboard the train for the seven minute return to Downtown Plano. There they exited the train for a brief tour of the immediate area.

The field study group re-boarded the train at Downtown Plano for the return trip to Pearl Station where they were joined by other members of the board for a tour of the AT&T Performing Arts Center's *Dee and Charles Wyly Theatre* and the *Margot and Bill Winspear Opera House*, followed by dinner at Jorge's Restaurant.

After dinner the group walked back to Pearl Station for the return to Westmoreland Station and Cedar Hill. The field study concluded at 11:02 p.m.
