



## SINGLE-FAMILY RENTAL REGISTRATION PROGRAM BEGINS JANUARY 1

The Cedar Hill City Council has adopted an ordinance establishing a new single-family rental registration program designed to improve communication with property owners and help keep Cedar Hill neighborhoods safe and clean. Beginning January 1, 2021, owners of single-family rental registration are required to register annually with the City and to complete a residential rental certificate of occupancy when the property is leased or when the tenant changes.

Property owners can complete their registration at [cedarhilltx.com/SFRR](http://cedarhilltx.com/SFRR) or in person at the Cedar Hill Government Center at 285 Uptown Blvd. Property owners who register before July 1 receive a discounted early registration fee.
