Trash and recycling normally collected on Thursday will be collected on Friday, November 26, and trash normally collected on Friday will be collected on Saturday November 27. Bulk and brush collections are not impacted by the holiday schedule.

CEDAR HILL IS 'SCENIC CITY' FOR 3RD CONSECUTIVE YEAR

Last month Cedar Hill was among 22 Texas cities that have been recognized as 2021 Certified Scenic City award recipients through the Scenic City Certification Program, a program of the statewide nonprofit and its 17 partner organizations. Cedar Hill has received the certification for the past three years and this year was upgraded to a 'Platinum' designation.

The Scenic City Certification Program recognizes cities for their demonstrated commitment to high-quality scenic standards for public roadways and spaces.

"This year followed similar trends as 2020, when Texans found themselves spending more time in their neighborhoods and considering investments in their immediate communities," said Sarah Tober, Scenic Texas President. "The Scenic City designation is fast becoming an acknowledgement that residents are committed to creating a more scenic environment for themselves and for visitors, whether that means creating scenic roadways, preserving historic sites, or improving parks and green spaces."

The Scenic City Certification Program is a nationally recognized, one-of-a-kind model, developed to provide communities with a comprehensive set of standards and evaluations for the design and development of public roadways and spaces.
