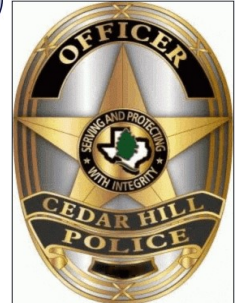

Significant Investigation

On 12-15-2021, Cedar Hill officers responded to an aggravated robbery call at 1000 E Pleasant Run Rd. The victim reported being robbed at gun point of his wallet and cell phone. Patrol officers were able to track the cell phone to another location within the apartment complex.

Upon arrival, they located the two suspects who immediately fled on foot. An officer stationed on the perimeter of the area of the offense observed a subject matching the description of one of the suspects walking down Pleasant Run Road. This suspect was detained and positively identified by the officer he fled from.

Further investigation led to the identification and arrest of the second suspect.
