THE NEW LAGOON NOW OPEN AT VIRGINIA WEAVER PARK

Memorial Day weekend marked the opening of Cedar Hill's newest facility - The Lagoon at Virginia Weaver Park.

The Lagoon is an outdoor community pool with 10,000 square feet of water surface, a separate lap swim pool, a lazy river, three-turn slide, and play features. Voters approved funding for the new pool in November 2017, and the pool's features and amenities were chosen through an extensive public input process.

The Lagoon is open through Tuesday through Sunday until August 12. Daily admission is \$5 for Cedar Hill residents and \$3 for Cedar Hill residents age 55+. Party room and cabanas are available for rent.
