What is a Pre-Development meeting?

A Pre-Development meeting is an informational meeting with city staff to help applicants prepare for the development application review process(es) that will be associated with your project, along with identifying potential issues and concerns, prior to a formal submission.

The Planning Department will not accept any development application without first having a Pre-Development Meeting with the applicant. Pre-Development meetings are held via Microsoft Teams (online) every Wednesday beginning at 2:30 p.m. There is no fee for this meeting.
